Nomination procedure	Partner institutions will receive an automatic e-mail approximately one month prior to the nomination submission date, requesting that they enter their nominees' information online. Instructions will be provided in the message.

Number of exchange students	Determined by mutual agreement between both institutions, and contingent upon the number stipulated in the Student Exchange Memorandum (SEM)

GPA	Minimum 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, or the equivalent

<b>Language requirements</b>  Proficiency in either English or Japanese.	Non-native English speakers wishing to participate in the English-language curriculum should possess one of the following scores: TOEFL iBT 79, IELTS 6.0, TOEIC 780, CEFR B2, or CET-6 485. (Students from Scandinavia, Germany, Austria, The Netherlands, Hong Kong and Singapore are exempt from this requirement, as are students who have an English language education background.)  Students intending to take university courses instructed in Japanese must possess N1/level 1 of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT), or the equivalent.
<b>Notification of acceptance (e-mail)</b>	Vis-à-vis April admission: Mid-late January; Vis-à-vis September admission: Mid-June.
<b>Transcript issuance</b>	Despatched to home university approximately four to six weeks after the completion of the exchange.

<b>Semester dates</b>	Autumn Semester: Oct 3 – Feb 8 Spring Semester: Apr 11 – Aug 7 (tentative)
<b>Credit load</b>	Minimum 15 (30 ECTS) credits per semester, or 30 (60 ECTS) per academic year

<b>Limitations regarding course selection</b>	1) NUPACE <i>Special Undergraduate</i> and <i>Special Graduate</i> Students majoring in Chemistry or Physics are generally <u>not</u> permitted to enrol in G30 courses with laboratory content. 2) Students wishing to apply for clerkships at the School of Medicine should follow application instructions on the NUPACE website carefully.
<b>Provision of language training courses</b>	Japanese and other foreign language classes are held during the semester for credit (free of charge).

### IV. Scholarships

<b>Scholarships</b>	Where allocated, Nagoya University will nominate highly-qualified students for a Student Exchange Support Program (JASSO) scholarship. Allowance: 80,000 JPY per month. Receipt is contingent upon entry into Japan.

### V. Accommodation

<b>Type of accommodation offered</b>	Under normal circumstances, successful applicants are housed in single rooms in student dormitories located either on-campus or within a short commute to the university.
<b>University housing fees</b>	25,000-45,000 JPY per month, including utilities.
<b>Application method</b>	NUPACE will apply for housing on the student's behalf.

### VI. Expenses (in local currency)

<b>Insurance</b>	Health (1,700 JPY per month) and personal liability insurance (1,800 JPY per annum)
<b>Food</b>	20,000-30,000 JPY per month
<b>Public transport</b>	Students living in <i>International Residence – Daiko</i> will pay 5,400 JPY per month in commuting expenses.
