Nomination deadlines	Please nominate your students at least 3-4 weeks prior to the application deadline, to give students enough time to complete the application process
Application deadlines	For a summer semester (April-July): January 10 For a winter semester (October - February): July 10
Accepted student nominations within bilateral exchange	Undergraduate and graduate students. Up to 5 students/semester
Duration of Exchange	One semester or one year
GPA requirement or other requirements	None
Language proficiency requirement	We strongly recommend a level of at least B2 according to the CEFR for classes in German and for classes in English; no certificate necessary
Required documents for application	Application form with the signature from the student and the signature and stamp from the home coordinator (has to be uploaded in the system, no hardcopy has to be send by mail). The link to the application portal will be sent directly to the student after the nomination

English-taught courses	Yes (But only for few limited courses.) Please feel free to contact us for any further questions. We strongly recommend at least a level of B2 according to CEFR.
Other	Participation in medicine classes are restricted and have to be cleared with the departmental coordinator. For those classes, German at a B2 level is mandatory: a certificate is necessary.

### Enrollment Requirements

Health insurance	<p>Sufficient health insurance coverage is required to be enrolled at our university. See <a href="#">here</a> for more information.  Our local immigration office requires the mandatory purchase of a German statutory health insurance (approx. 120€/month) in order to apply for a residence permit / a visa extension.</p>
Semester contribution	The semester contribution covers, amongst others, the transportation ticket in Marburg, Hesse and surroundings. It costs approx. 320€ for exchange students. For more information, see <a href="#">here</a> .
