ACADEMIC INFORMATION:	
<b>Semester Dates</b>	summer term: 1 April – 30 September – winter term: 1 October – 31 March
<b>2012/2013 Lecture Dates</b>	Winter term 2012/13: 15 October 2012 – 9 February 2013 Summer term 2013: 15 April – 20 July 2013 The intensive German language courses are held prior to the lecture period in March and September and run 4 weeks.
<b>Orientation</b>	Exchange students are invited to an orientation day which includes a guided sightseeing tour through Würzburg, a Welcome speech by the University President, and a reception with beverages and appetizers where students can talk to tutors, International Office staff, the Studentenwerk, the German language course coordinators, and others.
<b>Language Courses</b>	Students can take part in a 4-week intensive German course in September/March before the start of the lecture period. A second option is to take the German courses during the semester. All German courses are free of charge for exchange students. Participation in language courses other than German is possible, but requires registration. HOUSING AND ACCOMMODATION:	
<b>Housing Information</b>	<a href="http://www.studentenwerk-wuerzburg.de">http://www.studentenwerk-wuerzburg.de</a> → <b>WOHNEN</b>  The Studentenwerk is responsible for ten halls of residence in different locations throughout Würzburg. It is possible to rent single rooms (with shared kitchen and bathroom), single apartments or rooms in shared apartments, in which two to four students share a kitchen and bathroom. All rooms are furnished apart from crockery, cutlery, bed linen and towels. Rents range from € 160,00 to € 350,00 per month, depending on the size of the room/apartment and its equipment.  The tenancy agreements with the Studentenwerk always commence from the beginning of a semester on 1 April or 1 October. The Studentenwerk will try to ensure places for participants in preparatory language courses in March/September. Shorter tenancy periods are not possible. If students have to leave before their tenancy ends, they have to contact the Studentenwerk ahead of time.

<b>Housing Application Deadline</b>	15 June for the winter semester – 15 January for the summer semester
<b>Housing Deposit Information and Payment Methods</b>	A deposit of €200 has to be transferred to the bank account listed on the application form. The application can only be processed if the Studentenwerk receives a copy of the transfer form stamped by your bank and the program coordinator has confirmed the nomination.

OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION:	
<b>Insurance Requirements</b>	Adequate health insurance is required for registration. Home insurance companies should be contacted before departing to Germany.
<b>Immunization / Health Examination Requirements</b>	Home insurance companies should be contacted before departing to Germany.
<b>Visa Requirements</b>	Students coming from EU, EFTA and other OECD-countries (e.g. USA, Japan) do not need a visa to study in Germany. A valid passport or ID card is sufficient. <b>Estimated Living Expenses (per semester)</b>	approx. 550 - 700 Euro / month
<b>Bank account</b>	Students should think about opening a bank account to easily transfer the semester fee, rent, etc. Most banks offer student accounts free of charge. All you need to bring is your letter of admission or your confirmation of enrolment.

An <b>information package</b> will be sent after the application is received. The information package includes information on German courses, fees, tutors, and general information. The International Office provides a <b>program of excursions</b> every semester which includes among others a trip to Berlin or Munich.
