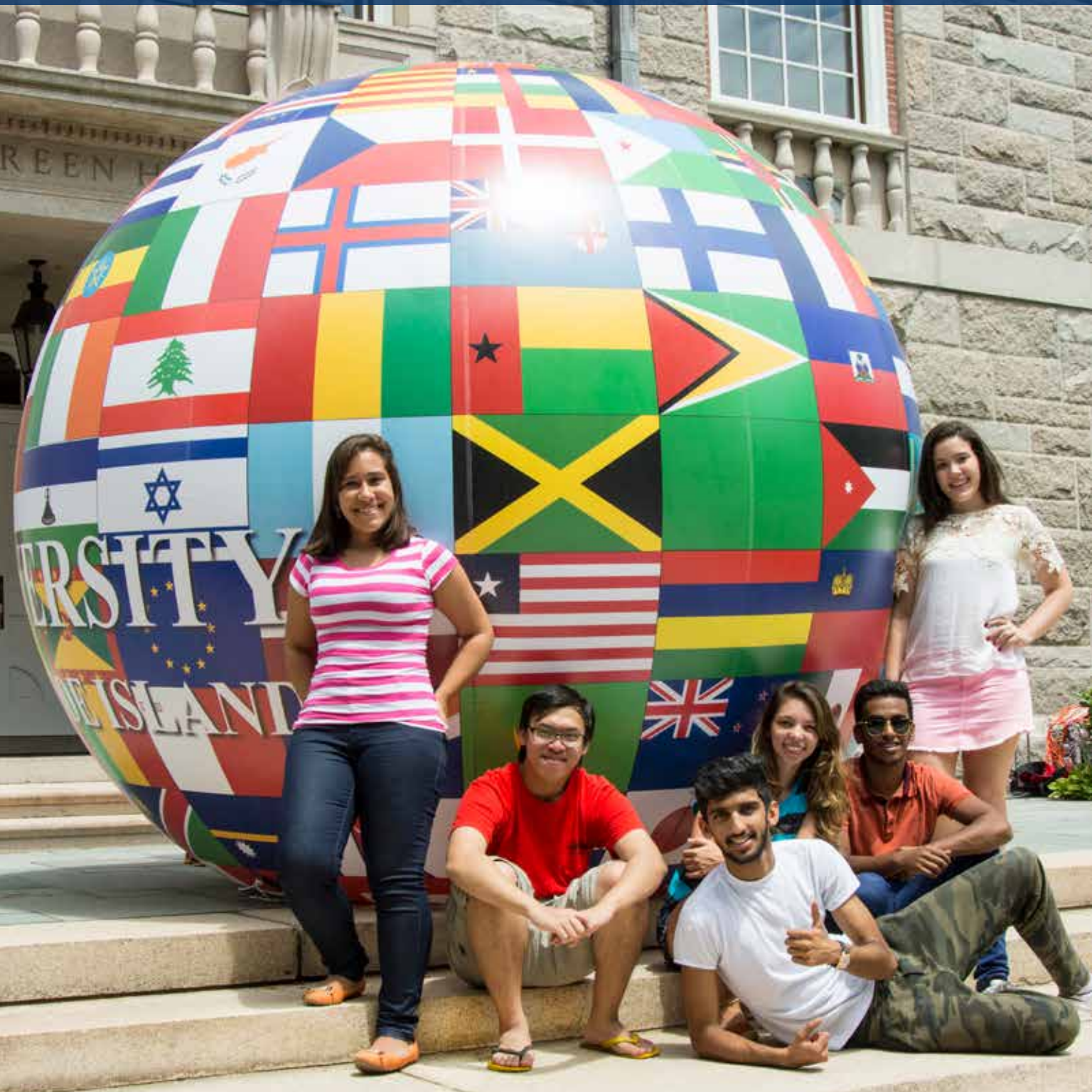

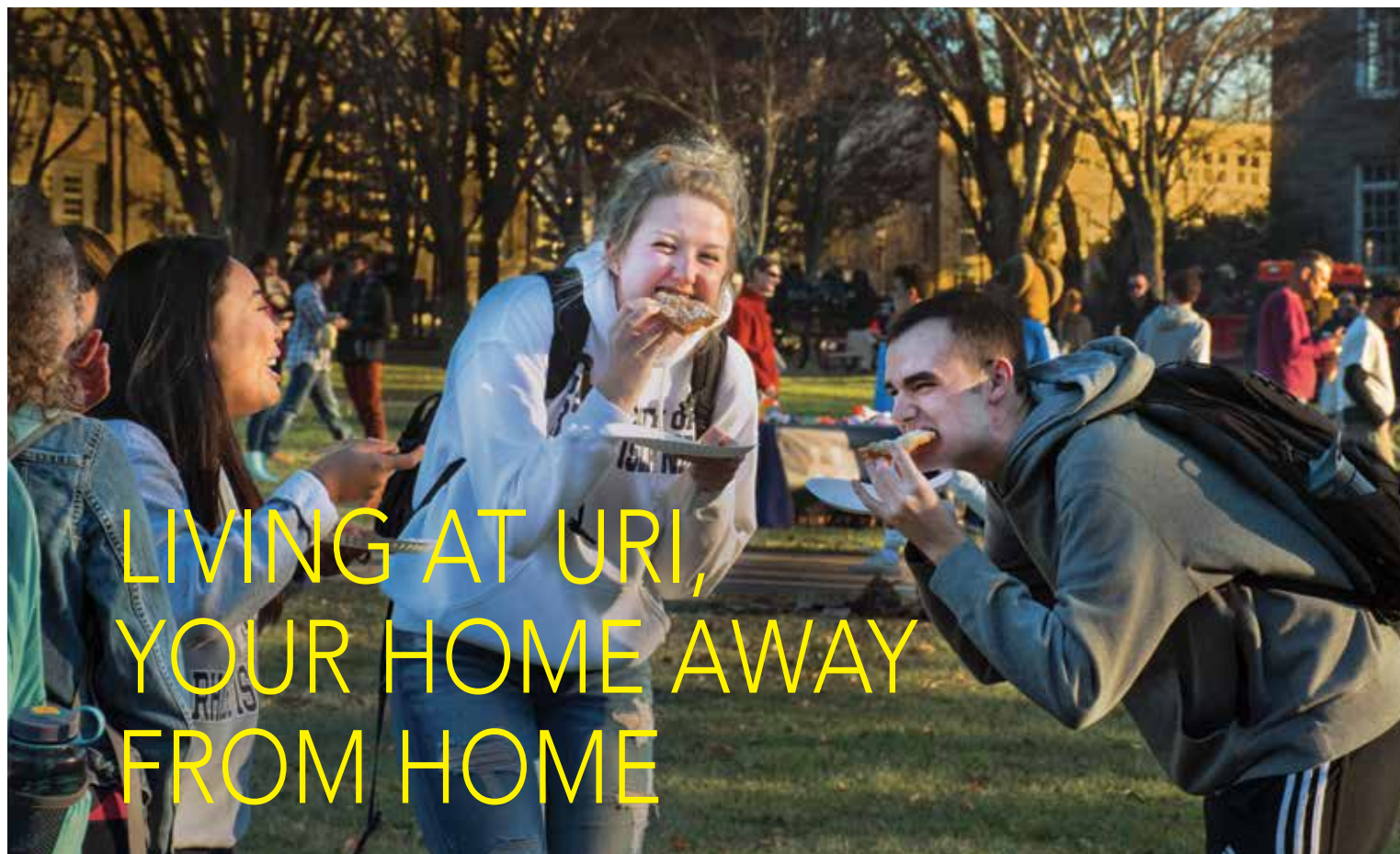

Housing in the International Engineering/Texas Instruments House is also available to all exchange students regardless of their field of study. uri.edu/iep-llc

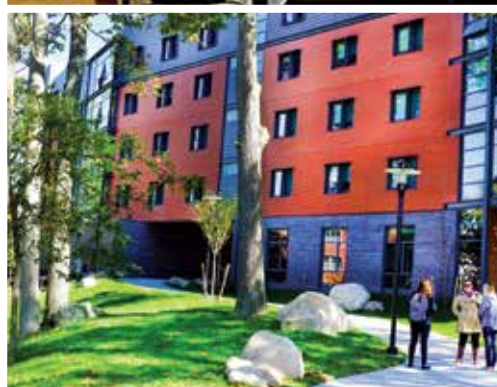
