Semester fulfillment	<p>- Students must have finished at least 2 semesters or equivalent before the application; transcript must show two semesters' result.</p> <p>* For transferred students, a minimum of one semester result from the transferred university should be shown on the official transcript.</p> <p>* Students must finish their degrees at their home universities after returning from exchange program (should not finish their last semester at Yonsei).</p>
GPA	<p>- 2.5 / 4.0 (B average) or above</p> <p>- ECTS (C or above)</p>
Language Proficiency	<p>- ENGLISH: If you plan to take courses taught in English, <u>TOEFL CBT 213 (IBT 79, PBT 550) or IELTS 6</u> is required.</p> <p>* Native English Speakers & Non-Native Speakers studying their degree in English are waived</p>
	<p>- KOREAN: If you plan to take courses taught in Korean, <u>KLAT level 4</u>, or an assessment report by a professor is required.</p> <p>* Students must get permission from the professor on the 1st day of class.</p>

Procedure	<p>1. Official nomination by home institution's exchange advisor should be made on Yonsei's online application system.</p> <p>2. Once nomination is received, students will be given log-in information and may proceed with the application procedure.</p> <p>* Further detail is provided late August.</p>
