## Academic Credit Transfer Information

The academic program will consist of a minimum of 30 contact hours with the opportunity to increase contact hours through classroom observation sessions and individual consultations with faculty members. A certificate of participation will be awarded to each participant. A letter confirming actual contact hours can be issued.

## Accommodation

Students will stay at in a hostel conveniently located close to campus and will be housed with 4 students in a room. The hostel has internet access, cooking and laundry facilities.

## Health Insurance

Health insurance is not included in the program fee. The purchase of travelers' health insurance prior to departure to Canada that is valid for the entire duration of travel is strongly recommended.
