

## Experience UC Davis in the Summer

## **IMPORTANT CONSIDERATIONS**

### **Visa Regulations**

Students staying in the U.S. with an F-1 student visa must be enrolled full-time in academic coursework. During the summer, GSP students need to be enrolled in a minimum of 12 units across the two summer sessions. The number of units per session, however, can vary. For example, a student could take 6 units each session, or 8 units one session and 4 units the next.

If students plan to enroll in only one summer session they must enroll in a minimum of 6 units.

### **Application Procedures**

GSP students must apply through their home university and the UC Davis Global Study Program. Our staff will work closely with students to ensure they are registered appropriately. ### **Program Costs**

The tuition and fees for the Global Study Program for Summer 2018 are \$6,825 for a full-time course of study in two sessions (12 units over two sessions) OR \$3,425 for a full-time course of study in one session (6 units). Fees include ongoing academic advising support, course registration fees, & extensive student services (library privileges, Activities and Recreation Center membership, internships, student clubs, etc.).
