Grande Ecole program

Grande Ecole program is one of Audencia Nantes' main program. It is a high quality 4-year program with a selective admission process for French students.

Courses begin with a core curriculum of one year for learning the fundamentals of management. At the end of this first year, students undertake an internship to practice all they have learnt in the first two semesters.

The Master cycle begins with the semester 3 and continues, after a gap year in the workplace, alternating the three following semesters: one semester of specialization in Nantes/one semester of study at a partner institution/one semester internship "Corporate Action"

• Grande Ecole core management courses

International students with at least 4 semesters of Business Studies can pick up courses from Semester 3.

Spring Semester: 10/02/2014 to 18/05/2014 (dates to be confirmed)

Courses only in English for the Spring Semester

• **Grande Ecole** specialization courses

International students with at least **7 semesters** in Business Studies can choose 2 electives and one of the 10 Majors taught in French or in English among the Master Program in Management Studies.
