For International Undergraduate Students


American Semester Abroad Program (ASAP) is a credit-bearing program that allows international students to take 12-18 credits during a semester spent abroad at the University of Notre Dame.



Program Highlights

- Welcome orientation and activities
- Excursion to Chicago
- Four-day overnight excursion to New York City (fall) and Orlando (spring)
- Face-to-face question and answer sessions with Graduate School admissions staff
- Live on campus as part of the Notre Dame community
- Official Notre Dame transcript upon semester completion
- Access to campus facilities





Eligibility

- International undergraduate students enrolled in a university overseas
- Sophomore or higher standing at home university
- Outstanding academic transcript (3.0 GPA or higher)
- High level of English language proficiency (IELTS 6.0 min., 6.5+ preferred; TOEFL 80 min., 90+ preferred; if TOEFL is between 80 and 90, the student will be required to take an English course)
- Students should possess exceptional motivation, emotional maturity, and a high aptitude for adapting to new environments

Additional Requirements

- One recommendation letter from a faculty member
- A personal record form filled out by a school official or your study abroad advisor
- Proof demonstrating enough funds to support study at Notre Dame
