Application Process

Nomination Deadlines	Please nominate your students at least 3-4 weeks prior to the application deadline, to give students enough time to complete the application process
Application Deadlines	For a summer semester (Apr-Jul): January 15 For a winter semester (Oct - Feb): July 15
Accepted Student Nominations	Undergraduate and graduate students. Up to 5 students/semester.
Duration of Exchange	One semester or one year
GPA Requirement or other Requirements	None
Language Proficiency Requirement	B2 for classes in German; B2 for classes in English (recommendation; no certificate necessary)
Required Documents for Application	Application form signed by the student as well as signed and stamped by the home institution's coordinator (upload to online system, no hardcopy required). The link to the application portal will be sent directly to the student after the nomination.
