Application

Nomination deadlines	Please nominate your students at least 3-4 weeks prior to the application deadline, to give students enough time to complete the application process
Application deadlines	For a summer semester (April-July): January 15 For a winter semester (October - February): July 15
Accepted student nominations	Undergraduate and graduate students
Duration of Exchange	One semester or one year
GPA requirement or other requirements	None
Language proficiency requirement	B2 for classes in German; B2 for classes in English (recommendation; no certificate necessary)
Required documents for application	Application form with the signature from the student and the signature and stamp from the home coordinator (has to be uploaded in the system, no hardcopy has to be sent by mail). The link to the application portal will be sent directly to the student after nomination
Orientation week	We recommend that your students take part in the orientation week. The orientation is offered twice per semester: - summer semester: first week of March (for students taking part in the intensive German class, see below) or first week of April. - winter semester: first week of September (for students taking part in the intensive German class, see below) or first week of October.
