



## Timeline for International Students

## January - February

- ✓ Review UC Davis' summer program details.
- ✓ Browse <u>courses</u> and <u>frequently asked questions</u>; full course descriptions are in the <u>catalog</u>. Discuss prospective courses with your adviser at your home university to determine how to transfer credit.
- ✓ Obtain a passport.
- ✓ Confirm you have satisfied the English proficiency requirement:

Acceptable Test	Minimum Score
Computer-based TOEFL	213
Internet-based TOEFL	80
Paper-based TOEFL	550
TOEIC	800
IELTS	7.0
GRE(verbal score)	140 - for tests taken after Aug 1, 2011

## March - June

✓ Application opens **March 1**. Apply as early as possible to have a greater selection of courses as well as enough time to obtain your F-1 visa. A complete application includes:

- ✓ Receive a Welcome Packet by FedEx with your I-20 and other important information.
- ✓ Plan courses and return a completed Course Report to staff by email.
- ✓ Register for courses online.
- ✓ Obtain appropriate visa status.
  - O New F-1 applicants: Apply for an F-1 visa at a U.S. consulate.
  - o Current F-1 students: Check with your adviser.
- ✓ Choose a health insurance option.
- ✓ Pay UC Davis tuition and fees online through MyBill.
- ✓ Arrange housing in Davis and confirm the date and time you will move in.
- ✓ Arrange transportation to Davis. Pay attention to important dates like orientation and the first day of class!

## June - August

- ✓ Welcome to Davis, California!
- ✓ Bring your passport, I-20 and Davis address to orientation.
  - o Session I orientation Friday, June 20; classes June 23 August 1, 2014
  - o Session II orientation Friday, August 1; classes August 4 September 12, 2014
