

The Undergraduate Summer School is open to students who are currently, or have been, studying at degree level. If your first language is not English, or the medium of instruction at your university is not English, you should demonstrate a 6.5 IELTS or equivalent. *The application deadline is 31 May 2018 and early application is advised.*

Accommodation

Accommodation costs £1,200 per session. It can be booked upon receiving an offer and includes a meal allowance. You will have a private en-suite room and each apartment has a communal, self-catering kitchen. All residences have a 24-hour security desk, on-site laundry facilities, WiFi, CCTV cameras and secure door entry systems. Accommodation is allocated on a first-come, first-served basis and early booking is advised.

- Application fee exemption: £0 (normally £40)

- GPA requirement: 3.0 (normally 3.3)

- Priority placement on the Summer School for applications submitted before **1 May 2018**
