General Information about Tokyo Tech	<p>Tokyo Tech is a leading Japanese university in science and technology with an outstanding history since 1881. There are 10,287 students (4,803 undergraduates, 5,100 postgraduates, and 94 research students), 1,147 faculty members and 568 administrative staff members. The institute consists of six graduate schools, three undergraduate schools, five research laboratories, and several research and service centers. There are 3 campuses in Ookayama, Suzukakedai and Tamachi. Visa Status / Procedure to obtain a student visa	<p>International students at Japanese universities are required to obtain a "student" visa. Obtaining "student" visa status is essential in order to apply for various kinds of assistance and scholarships for international students.</p> <p><Procedures to obtain a student visa> 1) After the application, the staff of the International Student Exchange Division apply for the student's COE (Certificate of Eligibility), a document necessary for obtaining a student visa. 2) The Immigration Bureau in Tokyo issues the COE and send it to Tokyo Tech. 3) The staff of Tokyo Tech send the COE to a student exchange officer of the partner university. 4) After the COE is handed to the student, the student goes to the Japanese Embassy/ Consulate in home country to obtain a student visa.</p>
Dormitory for Exchange Students	<p><Both YSEP and ACAP> After the applicant's enrollment has been formally accepted, about 1.5 months before enrollment, the staff of the Student Support Division will contact the student by email to provide information about dormitory.</p> <p>(Fees) 20,000 JPY-45,000 JPY per month (varies by dormitory)</p> <p>e.g.) Shofu/Umegaoka Dormitory: -Single Type Fee: 5,900 JPY/month (Charge for Lodging) 10,000 JPY/month (Maintenance Expenses) plus electricity and water expenses (Dependent on usage) - Double Type Fee: 5,950 JPY/month (Charge for Lodging) 6,500 JPY/month (Maintenance Expenses) plus electricity and water expenses (Dependent on usage)</p> <p>Komaba International House: Fee: 32,200 JPY/month Internet Fee: 2,700 JPY/month</p>
Apartment for International Students	<p>To search for a private apartment, the COOP service at Tokyo Tech is available for students after their enrollment. Useful information will be obtainable at the COOP office. After visiting some apartments, they can decide the one they will rent. Tokyo Tech will be an institutional guarantor when a student rent an apartment.</p>
Orientation for Exchange Students	<p>The date and place will be notified by the staff in charge of each program in due time. There is no charge for attending the orientation.</p>

Academic Record	<p>The record will be sent to each partner university at around the end of each semester.</p>
Insurance	<p>The following 3 types of insurance are compulsory for international exchange students:</p> <p>1) National Health Insurance: Their payment will be 30 % of the medical expense when they receive treatment at hospitals due to sickness/injuries. *It costs about 30,000 JPY per year. The exact cost varies by the municipal office where the student is registered.</p> <p><YSEP students></p> <p>2) Life Multi Insurance NR-Type by COOP: For general disease and accident insurance covering activities both inside and outside of the university.</p> <p>3) Personal Liability Insurance by COOP: For their legal liability in respect to bodily injury caused to a third party during daily life.</p> <p>*Life Multi Insurance NR-Type by COOP and Personal Liability Insurance by COOP cost 4,820 JPY in total per year.</p> <p><ACAP></p> <p>2) Disaster and Accident Insurance for Students (GAKKENSAL): Benefits will be paid in case of unexpected disasters or accidents during regular curricular/extracurricular activities and while commuting.</p> <p>3) Personal Liability Insurance for Students (GAKKENBAL): To identify students for personal liability provided for by law for injuries caused to a third party or properties damaged during regular curricular activities, school events and while commuting.</p> <p>*Disaster and Accident Insurance for Students (GAKKENSAL) & Personal Liability Insurance for Students (GAKKENBAL) cost 1,340 JPY in total per year.</p>
