Experience Notre Dame through the American Semester Abroad Program (ASAP) that allows students to take courses at Notre Dame for one or two semesters and become part of the ND family.



Eligibility

- International undergraduate students enrolled in a university outside the U.S.
- Sophomore or higher standing at home university
- Outstanding academic transcript (3.0 GPA or higher)
- High level of English language proficiency (IELTS 7.0 min.; TOEFL 90 min.; a phone interview might be required)
- Students should possess exceptional motivation, emotional maturity, and a high aptitude for adapting to new environments

Application Requirements

- Online application questionnaire and documents
- A personal record form filled out by a school official or your study abroad advisor (only for students who have not been nominated by their institution.)
- Proof of sufficient funds to support study at ND
