Application

Nomination deadlines	Please nominate your students at least 3-4 weeks prior to the application deadline, to give students enough time to complete the application process
Application deadlines	For a summer semester (April-July): January 15 For a winter semester (October - February): July 15
Accepted student nominations within bilateral exchange	Undergraduate and graduate students. Up to 5 students/semester
Accepted student nominations outside bilateral exchange as freemovers https://www.uni-marburg.de/en/studying/studying-at-umr/exchange/freemover	Undergraduate and graduate students. Up to 5 students/semester Note: UMR cannot offer housing in student dormitories for freemover students!
Duration of Exchange	One semester or one year
GPA requirement or other requirements	None
Language proficiency requirement	We strongly recommend a level of B2 according to the CEFR for classes in German and for classes in English; no certificate necessary

Required documents for application	Application form with the signature from the student and the signature and stamp from the home coordinator (has to be uploaded in the system, no hardcopy has to be send by mail). The link to the application portal will be sent directly to the student after the nomination
Language classes	Pre-session German intensive class: One-month intensive German class before the beginning of the semester. Before a summer semester: in March; before the winter semester: in September. 300€ participation fee (fee includes tuition, materials and one excursion) General language classes: Language classes are also available during the semester (once or twice a week) Language Center: www.uni-marburg.de/en/language-center

Other	Participation in medicine classes are restricted and have to be cleared with the departmental coordinator. For those classes, German at a B2 level is mandatory: a certificate is necessary.

Enrollment Requirements

Health insurance	Sufficient health insurance coverage is required to be enrolled at our university. See here for more information. Our local immigration office requires the mandatory purchase of a German statutory health insurance (approx. 90€/month) in order to apply for a residence permit / a visa extension.
Semester contribution	The semester contribution covers, amongst others, the transportation ticket in Marburg, Hesse and surroundings. It costs approx. 280€ for exchange students. For more information, see here .
