Eligibility

- Open to cohorts of students or individuals currently registered in a degree program at a designated post-secondary institution
- English language proficiency of at least 70 iBT in TOEFL, or equivalent

Academic Credit Transfer Information

- A letter of participation confirming actual contact hours will be presented to each participant
