Program Overview

Classroom Study

Each course includes 16 hours of instruction, delivered in two-hour morning and afternoon class segments. The instructors will encourage and lead students through discussions of complex engineering and information science topics. Classes will culminate with a final exam. All courses will be in English. Students will receive a certificate upon successful completion of the program.

Cultural Visits

China Executive Leadership Programs staff will plan cultural events and accompany the group on field trips to famous modern and historical attractions in Chicago, St. Louis, and Springfield.

Supervised Group Out-of-State Travel

Following the end of the program, students will have a 7day group trip with a chaperone from the China Executive Leadership Programs. Students will visit key tourist sites, world-class universities and government organizations in Chicago, Washington D.C. and New York City before departing for China.

The Courses

Control Systems



This course will focus on modeling of linear dynamic systems, Laplace transform techniques, linear feedback control systems, stability criteria, and design techniques.

Information Science & Strategy



This class addresses how to evaluate, select and manage information systems that will be used in the daily operation of information centers. It includes the systems used by technical staff and the information consumers. Course will focus on information as a product. Attention is given to the operation of an organization

as a whole and the impact of change on the integration of resources, work flow and usability. Formal methods for modeling systems, and industry practice techniques of analysis are used to address these problems and opportunities.

Program Fees

Program Fee includes tuition, training materials, cultural activities, use of university facilities, and local transportation through the Champaign-Urbana mass transit bus system. *\$3000 per person*

Campus Housing Fee (14 days on campus): Double occupancy room: *\$260 per person* Single occupancy room: *\$400 per person*

Campus Meal Fee includes breakfast and dinner at Illinois Street Residence Hall. Other meals are at the participants' additional expense. *\$230 per person*

Cultural Travel Fee includes a 7-day group trip with a CELP chaperone. Students will visit key tourist sites in Chicago, Washington D.C. and New York City before departing for China. The travel fee does <u>not</u> include airfare, meals, or any other miscellaneous expenses (hotel tips, bus driver tips, souvenirs, etc.). *\$900 per person*
