

Program Overview

Classroom Study

Each course includes 16 hours of instruction, delivered in two-hour morning and two-hour afternoon class segments. The instructor will encourage and lead students through discussions of complex issues relating to Development Economics and Money and Banking. Classes will culminate with a final exam. All courses will be in English. Students will receive a certificate upon successful completion of the program.

Business Visits

Students will participate in meetings with executives from key Illinois corporations. These corporations are prized for their economic development strategies, social responsibility, and employee satisfaction. Visits to various companies and banks provide a great opportunity to gain first -hand knowledge of U.S. business.

Cultural Visits

China Executive Leadership Programs staff will plan cultural events and accompany the group on field trips to famous modern and historical attractions in Chicago, St. Louis, and Springfield.

The Courses

Development Economics

This course focuses on the application of economic reasoning and analysis to business decision-making. Topics may include demand and supply analysis, estimation of demand by firms, pricing and non-price competition in contested markets, game theoretic perspectives on business strategy, and other topics of interest.

Money and Banking

This course will focus on the forces (information and transaction costs) that have propelled the historical evolution of money, credit, and financial intermediation from the ancient world to present. Related financial institutions such as bond, stock, and insurance markets are also explored. In addition, the course will cover the structure of the Federal Reserve System & bank regulation.

Program Fees
